His mother represents the **Traditional Moral Compass**, while the supporting cast provides the comedic relief and the grounded reality of the working class.

The success of *Bikeman* in the 720p and 1080p digital distribution markets (Sub-Indo and beyond) indicates a broad appeal for stories that humanize the working class while providing high-quality entertainment. The franchise has paved the way for more nuanced portrayals of Southeast Asian urban life, moving away from caricatures and toward multidimensional characters.
