- High-Definition Digital Capture: Replacing the video tape (VT) aesthetic of the 1980s with 4K resolution.
- Minimalist Set Design: Focusing on the 'intimate storytelling' format to cater to both television audiences and social media snippets.
- Legacy Scripting: Maintaining the linguistic DNA of the original series while adapting the humor for contemporary sensibilities.

Mathematical Models of Satire in 'Blackadder Goes Forth'
